### CONNECTED Africa Launch Conference

Our Africa Launch Conference took place in early May in Kampala, Uganda. Thank you to all who attended, presented and contributed so much to a successful event.

We are particularly grateful to all at [NaCRRRI](#) and [NARO](#) for hosting the second day of the conference, and to [Scriptoria](#) for facilitating a two-day training workshop aimed at early career researchers, which concluded conference week.

#### **Conference confirms network's growing strength**

*A plant science conference in Uganda which drew together dozens of world-class researchers from across Sub-Saharan Africa and the UK this month has confirmed the growing strength of a network whose collaborations promise to deliver solutions to devastating crop diseases in the years ahead.*

*Delegates from 10 African countries joined counterparts from the UK at the CONNECTED Virus Network Africa Launch Conference, which took place in Kampala, Uganda, from 7-9 May. It was immediately followed by a two-day training workshop aimed at early career researchers looking to develop skills including research grant proposal writing.*

### Pump-prime funding update

Applications for the CONNECTED Virus Network's first pump-prime funding call opened in March 2018 ... and applications for the second call will become available later in 2018.

For the first round, a preliminary 'expression of interest' process concluded in early April, attracting dozens of funding proposals. Those selected to progress to the full application stage were given until 24 June to submit their full proposal.

Grants of up to £30,000 are being made available, though a small number of larger projects up to £90,000 may be funded. Projects should run for between three and 12 months and should lead to relevant and useful outputs for this field or produce pilot data that can be used in larger grant applications to national / international funders.

- Put in place plans for a CONNECTED Development Programme, to be run in 2019
- Expand the resources available on the CONNECTED website, particularly those available to support network members
- Develop elements of the project to encourage people from other research areas to work with us, making it a truly interdisciplinary project
